Here's an apron that is made in a jiffy and put on and off in a jiffy, too. Clip-on aprons are quick to sew up and a novel little present to give.

*Directions:* Buy one curved plastic ring (most notion counters and sewing centers have them). Use  $\frac{3}{4}$  yard of fabric for each apron you make. If you use seersucker or any of the new drip-dry cottons, there'll be no ironing involved. One ring and several aprons — both plain and fancy — make a very nice gift, especially for the young homemaker.
